Dear Parents of Students in our Kindergarten and First Grade Classes,

We are delighted to have your child dancing with us at The Dance Foundation for our 2022-2023 season! We want to share with you our plans for the spring performance. We will have five separate shows to accommodate our 3-year-old through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade classes to keep the event short and audience small. Each class will be assigned to one of the performance times listed below.

**Performance dates (each class will only be assigned one of the following):**

Saturday, May 6, 2023 – 1:00 or 3:00

Sunday, May 7, 2023 – 1:00, 3:00, or 5:00

**The Performance fee:** First half due November 15<sup>th</sup>

This fee includes your dancer's costume, which belongs to them after the performance. The performance fee also covers production costs and a digital video download of your performance produced by Music Techniques. There are no tickets required for the performance. All are welcome! If your child is also in a tap class, there will be an additional \$60 fee for their tap costume pieces. Tap students will have a costume that will be used for both their ballet and tap class, with changes in skirts and accessories, which will keep the costume change simple for these young dancers.

Half of your total recital fee will be billed October 15th and will be **AUTO-DRAFTED** on November 15<sup>th</sup> from your card on file. If you would like to pay the total recital fee at this time, please contact us.

Performance Fee: \$165

Additional Fee for Tap Students: \$60

**If your child will not participate in the recital, please notify our office by November 1<sup>st</sup>.**

Otherwise a costume will be ordered for your dancer and you will be obligated for half of the performance fee, as stated in our policies.
